### How do I access my Point-of-Care resource(s)?

When your practice or institution subscribes to a *Point-of-Care* resource, your access may be authenticated by your computer's internet address or your intranet. If you see your organization's name in the upper right of the screen, your session is authenticated. If you have questions about how to access a *Point-of-Care* resource through your organization's site license, please contact your librarian or administrator.

### How do I use my Point-of-Care resource(s)?

The quickest way to find content is via a search. All content is easily accessible on the home page, the top navigation menu, and the footer links.

### Should I sign in?

Your access to the online site is provided through your organization's preferred method. If you also sign in with your individual AAP Login while accessing the site license, you will be able to sign in remotely.
