

## How do I access *Pediatric Patient Education*?

When your practice or institution subscribes to *Pediatric Patient Education*, your access may be “authenticated” by your computer’s internet address or your intranet. If you see your organization’s name near the upper right of the screen, your session is authenticated. If you have questions about how to access *Pediatric Patient Education* through your organization’s subscription, please contact your librarian or administrator.

## How do I use *Pediatric Patient Education*?

The **quickest way to find content is via a search**. All content is easily accessible via the home page, the top navigation menu, and the footer links. Additionally, patient education handouts can be found by using *ICD-10-CM* or *CPT*® codes.

## Should I sign in?

Your access to the online site is provided through your organization’s preferred method. If you also sign in with your individual AAP Login while accessing the site license, you will then be able to sign in remotely and access from any device.

## What about mobile access?

When your session is authenticated or you are signed in, the responsive design of the *AAP Publications* online platform **adjusts automatically to your device**.
